RE: Industrial Action

You may be aware from media coverage that the National Education Union (NEU) has declared strike action, which will take place on the following dates:

- Wednesday 01 February
- Tuesday 28 February
- Wednesday 15 March
- Thursday 16 March

The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teachers' pay, and not because of any issues at our school.

I am sorry to inform you that New Heights School (Key Stage 4 / LEEP) will be closed on Wednesday 01 February. We are asking you not to send your child into school on this day.

We have not taken this decision lightly. We remain committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our pupils, and feel that we would be unable to provide this with the staff we have available.

Works will be available, online, for students on this day.


